As a Catholic convert from protestant fundamentalism, the theology of the Eucharist was not initially on my radar. On my journey into the Church, the main stumbling block (or "Rock") was the teaching authority of the Church, the Papacy.

I read a book called 'The Keys of This Blood' by Malachi Martin. If you read this book, you would think it would have turned me away from the Catholic Church (it is anti-Catholic), but in reality, the writer made me realize the significance of Matthew 16:18: "And I say to thee: That thou art Peter; and upon this rock I will build my church, and the gates of hell shall not prevail against it." This verse came alive for me as I realized that an infallible teaching of Devine revelation is essential to ensure that the Truth is maintained and proclaimed throughout the Christian era until Christ returns. Private interpretation of scripture is dangerous, if not in union with Devine revelation from the Chair of Peter (the Papacy).

Even though I didn't completely understand all the deposit of faith, which Christ's Church taught (the Eucharist included), I submitted to the Church, based on the teaching authority given to it by Christ himself. The Chair of Peter (the Apostolic Succession of popes) has the keys to the kingdom. This was a life changing revelation for me. I had found what I was looking for amid all the confusing and divisive doctrines of protestant fundamentalism.
